

## Prayer Items

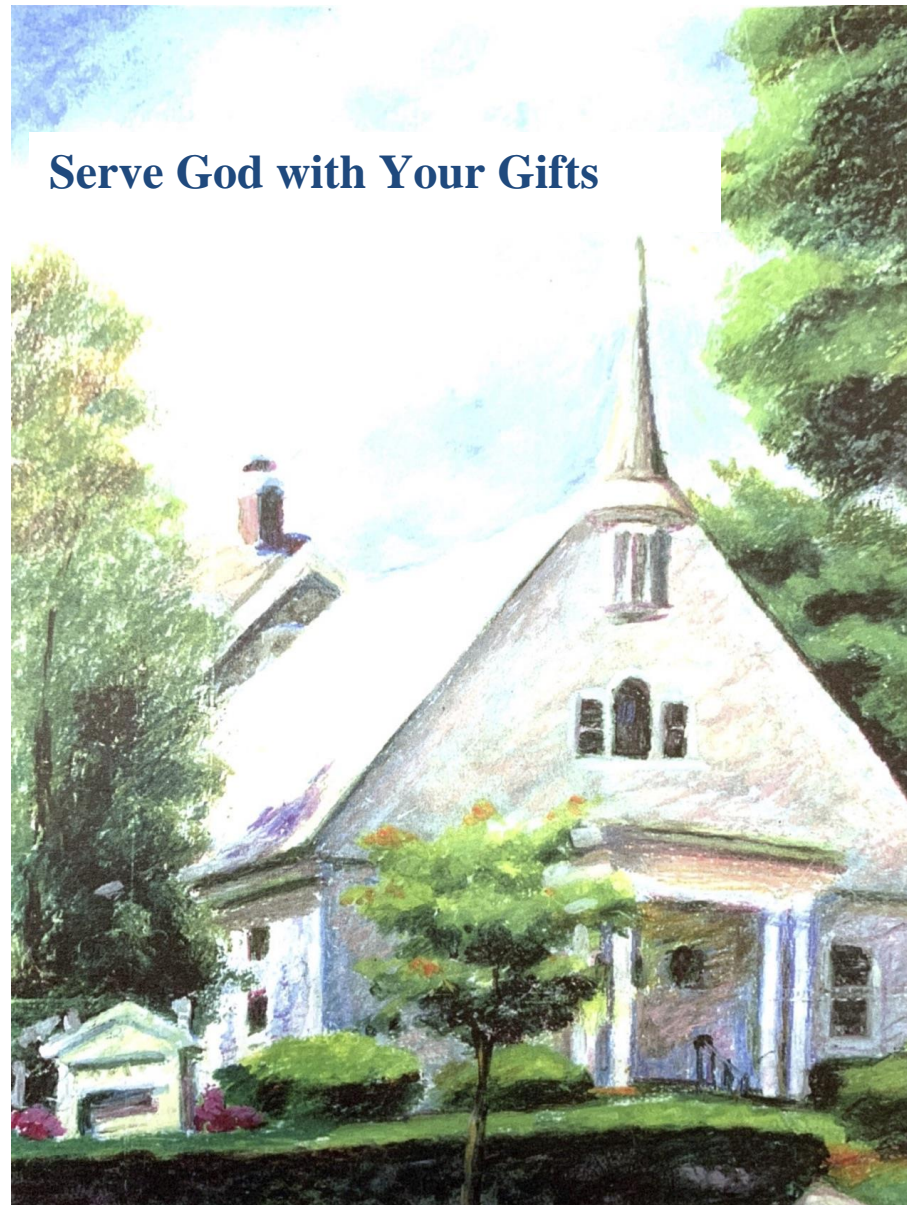
1. Please pray for our Board and various leaders as they plan for Holy Week events -- and also for the physical reopening of our church.
