

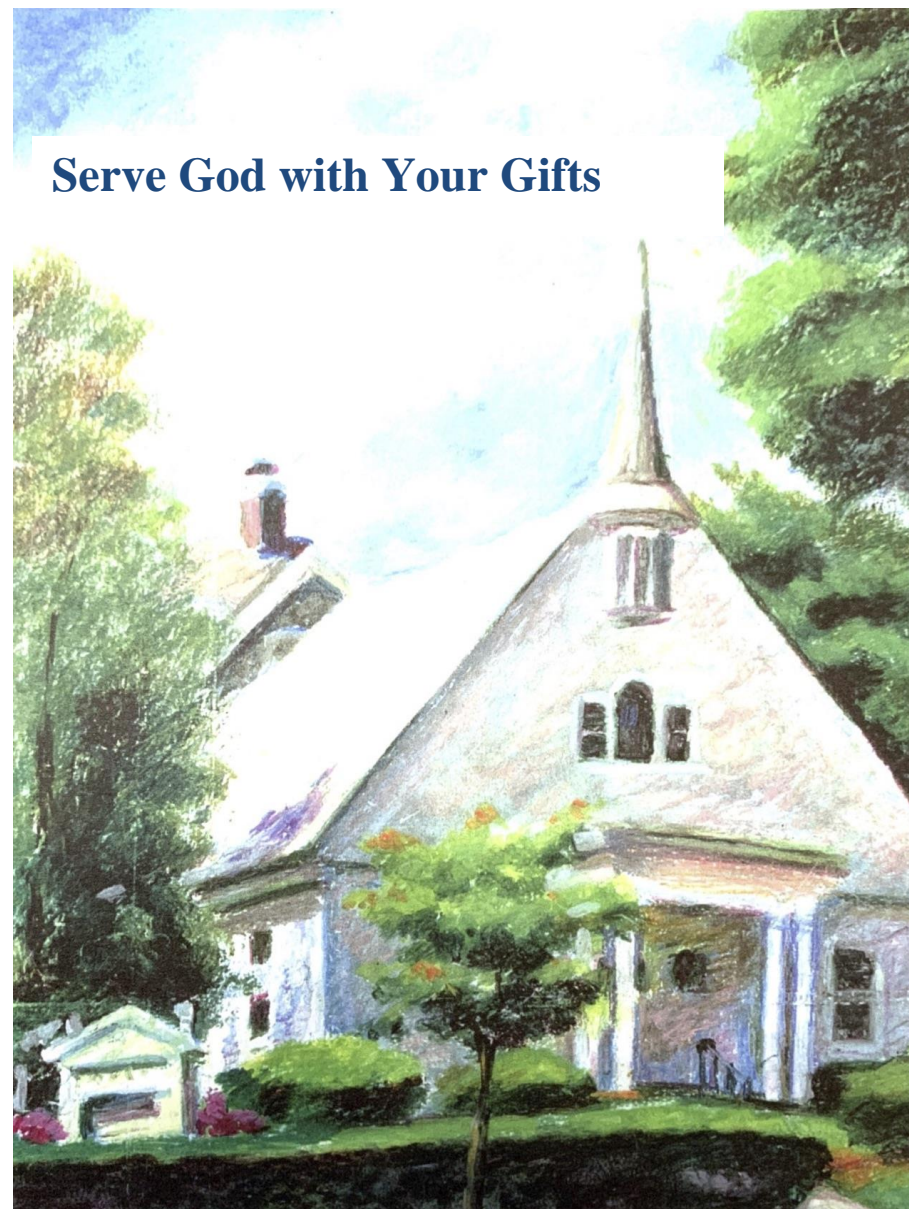
Prayer Items
