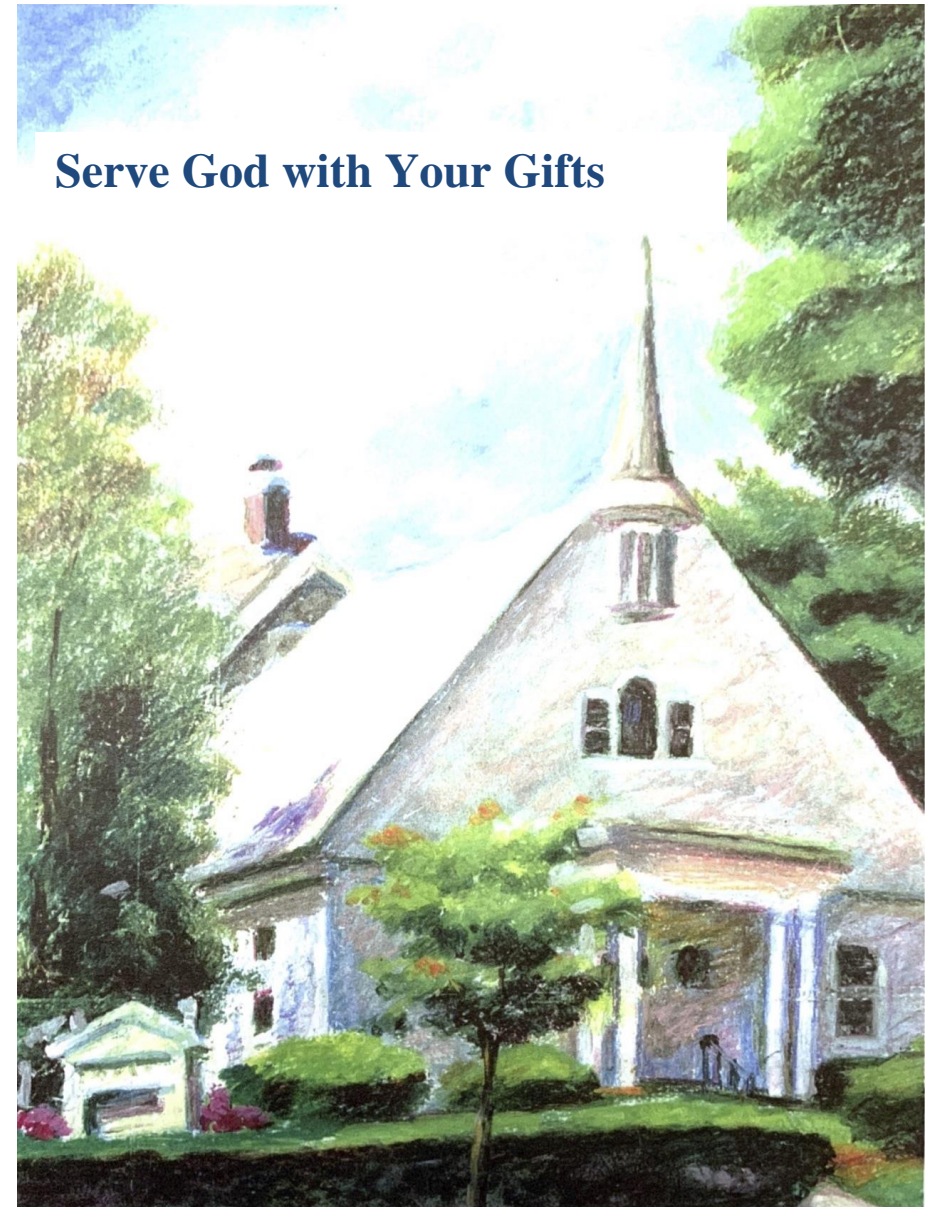


Prayer Items
