
Prayer Items

- 1. We welcome everyone to worship God with us this morning. May peace be with you and your family.

Our other protocols remain in place, and pre-registration is still required. We will continue to livestream all services. Beyond that, we simply encourage everyone to make wise choices based on their health and vaccination status. - 3. During our worship services today we will celebrate Communion. For those of you joining us online: If you are a baptized Christian and would like to participate, please prepare ahead of time a small amount of juice and bread. (Grape juice and bread or matzoh would be ideal.) We look forward to this special time together.
- 4. Sunday worship requires more manpower, mainly for the production of slides for worship, video production, and audio/lighting control. You don't need much foundation because our technical team will provide training. What we need is your dedication and committment to serve the Lord. If you are willing, please contact Brother Te or Brother Feng. Thanks!
- 5. As you may be aware, our church suffered considerable water damage from the remnants of hurricane Ida on Sept 1. The basements of both the sanctuary and the parsonage were flooded. All the equipment in the parsonage basement was damaged and has been replaced. We are planning for more repair and additional work to improve the basement. So far, the equipment replacement has cost us \$14,000, and we expect to incur additional \$20,000 upwards to repair the basements. We do not have flood insurance. Our year-to-date giving is currently \$201 thousand (\$54 thousand below budget). We do have a \$326 thousand reserve of general fund in the bank, but it would be prudent not to draw too much upon this because it is our emergency fund. We are asking church members to contribute financially to this repair work. If you would like to give, please designate your contribution to "Building Maintenance".
