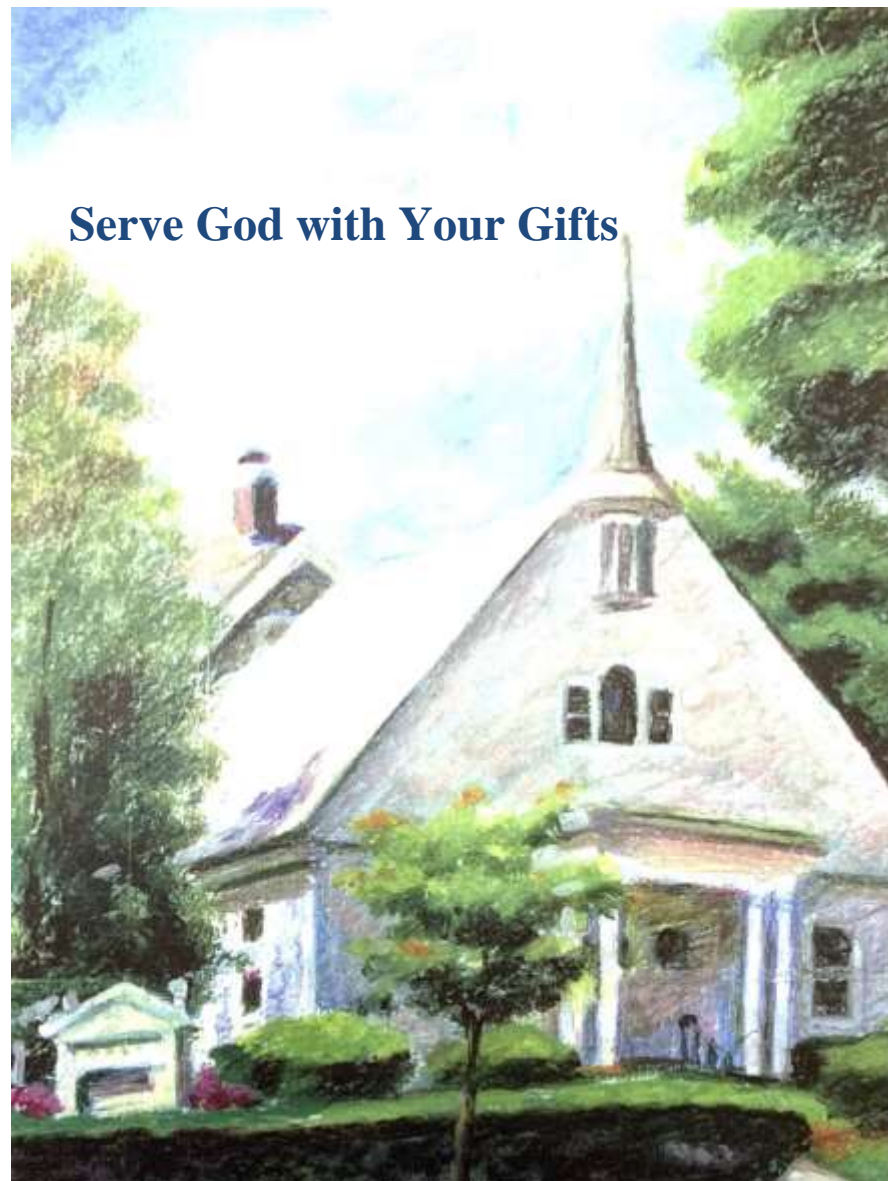


Prayer Items

3. We have removed the capacity limits on our service attendance. (We still ask that, if you have any symptoms or are aware of having been recently exposed to COVID, you refrain from coming.) We will continue to require the wearing of masks, and will be exercising other safety precautions. If you're able, please join us for worship!
4. If you are an active (voting) member of CACW, please keep an eye on your email inbox! A ballot will come your way this week so that you can vote on two candidates for congregational Nominating Committee members. (The Nominating Committee identifies candidates for next year's Governing Board, whom you will vote on later in the year.) This year's congregational candidates are Eileen Dang and Peggy Chen. Voting is quick and easy--and we ask that you respond promptly. Thank you!
5. We are excited about our church's upcoming Missions Weekend events. On Saturday 11/13, workshops will be offered (by Zoom) by Sarah Hui (2-3:30pm), Lily Horng (4-5pm), and Pastor Ed Stuart (7-8pm). On Sunday 11/14, Pastor Ed will preach in the English service and Stephen Li in the Chinese. Please plan on joining us for this important time.
6. As you may be aware, our church suffered considerable water damage from the remnants of hurricane Ida on Sept 1. The basements of both the sanctuary and the parsonage were flooded. All the equipment in the parsonage basement was damaged and has been replaced. A task force has been formed to focus on the restoration and improvement of the basement. So far, we have replaced equipment that cost about \$14,000, and we expect to incur more than \$35,000 of additional repairs. We do not have flood insurance. Since we made our last announcement, we received about \$24,000 of offering towards the Building Maintenance fund. We thank everyone for your prayers and financial support. Please continue to pray for the task force and restoration efforts. If you would like to give, please designate your contribution to "Building Maintenance".
