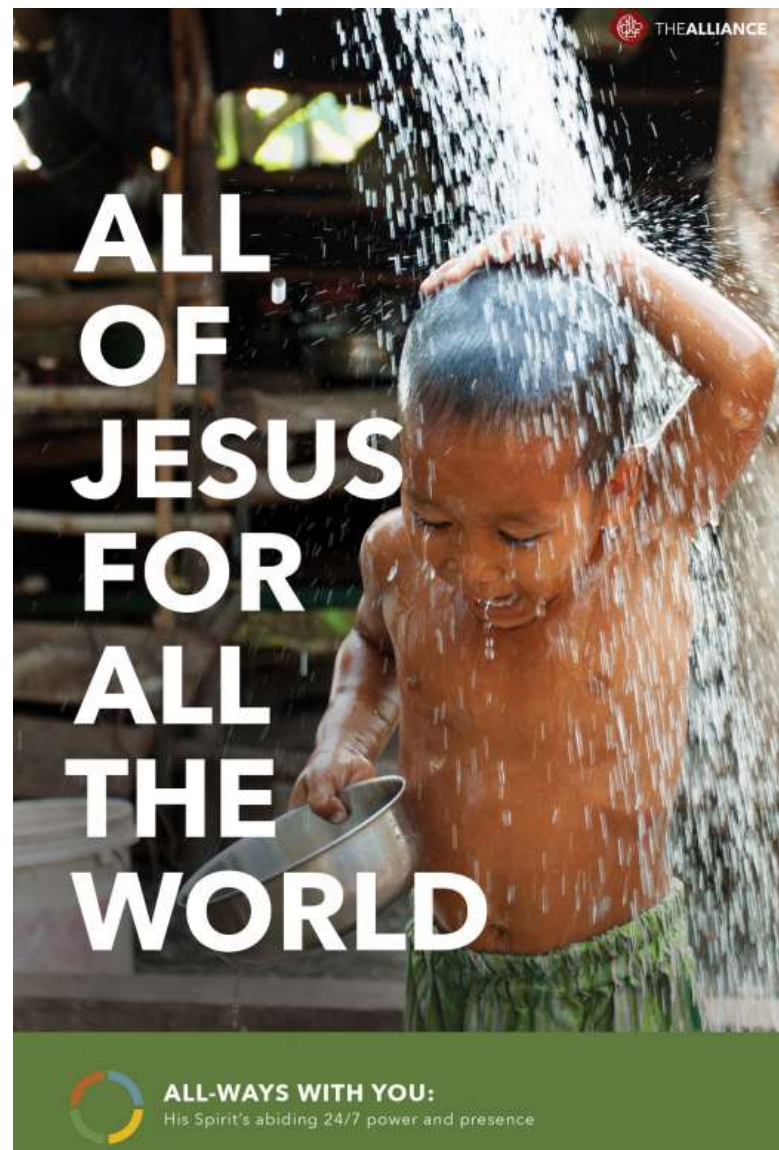


Prayer Items
