

Prayer Items



3. In light of recent societal events, Pastor Alan delivered a heartfelt & biblical centered sermon last Sunday (6/7) in English service. 4. Next Sunday (6/21) we will hold our June communion during both worship services. We will also celebrate Father's Day with the presentation of our virtual rendition of "The Blessing." For those who are baptized, please prepare your hearts and simple crackers and grape juice to partake in communion together.
5. Congratulations to Pastor Pablo and his wife, Kim. The Garcia family is expanding--expecting a baby in November. Please pray, as always, for God's gracious help for first-time parents—and also for the health of the whole family especially in the midst of the pandemic.
6. Praise God for the continued hard work of the Pastoral Search Committee (PSC). Our candidate, Brother Shyhyann Lee—together with his wife, Joyce—have met with various fellowships in the last two weekends. This Sunday (6/14) the PSC will host a "town hall" for Q&A regarding the PSC process. The Board is working on a few, remaining steps to facilitate the eventual congregational vote. Please continue to pray for God's blessing on Brother Lee and his family, on our church, and God's gift of wisdom and discernment to all of us.
7. Remember the PEAK (church health) survey we did a few months ago? The Board had originally planned to share the survey results at the March Membership meeting. The pandemic delayed that meeting. Instead of waiting for the time when we can regather in person at church, we are preparing an executive summary of the PEAK results to share with you next Sunday (6/21). In the meantime, thanks both for your participation and your patience.
8. The Gospel Camp we attended regularly (Harvey Cedar, NJ) will be held online this year from 7/31 to 8/1/2020, 7:30 PM-9:30 PM US EDT. Brother Peter Liu will share on the theme, "Through the Storm." Please pray for this event; although the format has changed, our Lord's heart for the gospel remains the same. Pray for God's presence, for hearts to be prepared, and for the advance of the gospel.

In responding to the unusual circumstances as of result of COVID-19, the UConn Financial Risk Management program has announced options such as taking online courses in Fall 2020 and deferred enrollments of the newly accepted students. Consequently, it is expected that the number of new UConn students who can join the programs in person in Fall 2020 will be lower. Please continue to pray for UConn ministry (Seeds) for God's leading to care for the students."
