Prayer Items


- 1. Please pray for our country (and the world) as people and governments grapple with a variety of societal issues, as well as with matters of justice. May God's heart be known and God's will be done.

- Our current plan is to reopen our church physically in September for church gatherings with appropriate precautions. In the meantime, we will be looking for ways to encourage fellowship and connection to keep our community united and strong.
- We would like to thank Ruth Chan and Daniel Li for their services as election
 officials at the congregational vote of calling of Brother Shyhyann Lee. May the
 Lord bless them and their families.
- 4. More than 530 people from 20+ churches have registered for Gospel camp. We encourage all members to invite friends and families to participate. (Since the event will be held online via Zoom, distance is not an issue.) Registration only requires name, believer or not, and email address. You can register via Gospel camp website or contact Sister Nancy Ma (nancyma0701@gmail.com) to register so we know the total count of participants from our church. There is no cost to gospel friends. - Thank you for your generosity during this difficult time. May's offering income was \$28K, and expense was \$23K, giving a surplus of \$5K. June's offering income was \$19.3K, and expense was \$20.5K, giving a deficit of \$1.2K. Year-to-date June deficit is \$9K.
- 6. A profound thank you to all who have contributed toward CACW's COVID-19 Relief Fund. To date, we have collected \$8,080. So far, the funds have gone primarily toward inventorying and distributing protective masks, and also to help a few local families in need. If you are aware of financial hardship among our congregation or community, please bring it to the attention of one of our pastors or Board members.
- 7. We're glad that a number of you have made contributions in honor of our dear, recently departed sister, Sharon Yen. In line with the family's wishes, those funds have been allocated to missions work through our denomination's Great Commissions Fund. As always, financial giving is handled by our church in a strictly confidential way. But if any of you who contributed want to let the Wang family know, we're sure they would be encouraged to hear from you.
- 8. In responding to the unusual circumstances as of result of COVID-19, the UConn Financial Risk Management program has announced options such as taking online courses in Fall 2020 and deferred enrollments of the newly accepted students. Consequently, it is expected that the number of new UConn students who can join the programs in person in Fall 2020 will be lower. Please continue to pray for UConn ministry (Seeds) for God's leading to care for the students."
