- 4. This year many churches, including ours, had to cancel planned short term mission trips due to the pandemic. Our hosting organization, Envision in Ecuador, who depends on the income of hosting churches, is suffering financially. The improvished communities they serve are also suffering due to lack of outside help. We ask that you remember them in your prayer.
- Pray for our church's ongoing efforts to provide needed food to families in Port Chester—including our exploration of a partnership with the non-profit organization "Feeding Westchester."
- 6. Please continue praying for God's comfort and strength for Charles, Sean and Linda Wang as they grieve the loss of Sharon, beloved wife and mother.
- 7. Let's please continue praying earnestly for front-line workers (medical and otherwise)—both those who are part of our church family, and others. Pray for protection, strength, energy, comfort and a sure sense of God's presence and care.

- 9.
