

Prayer Items

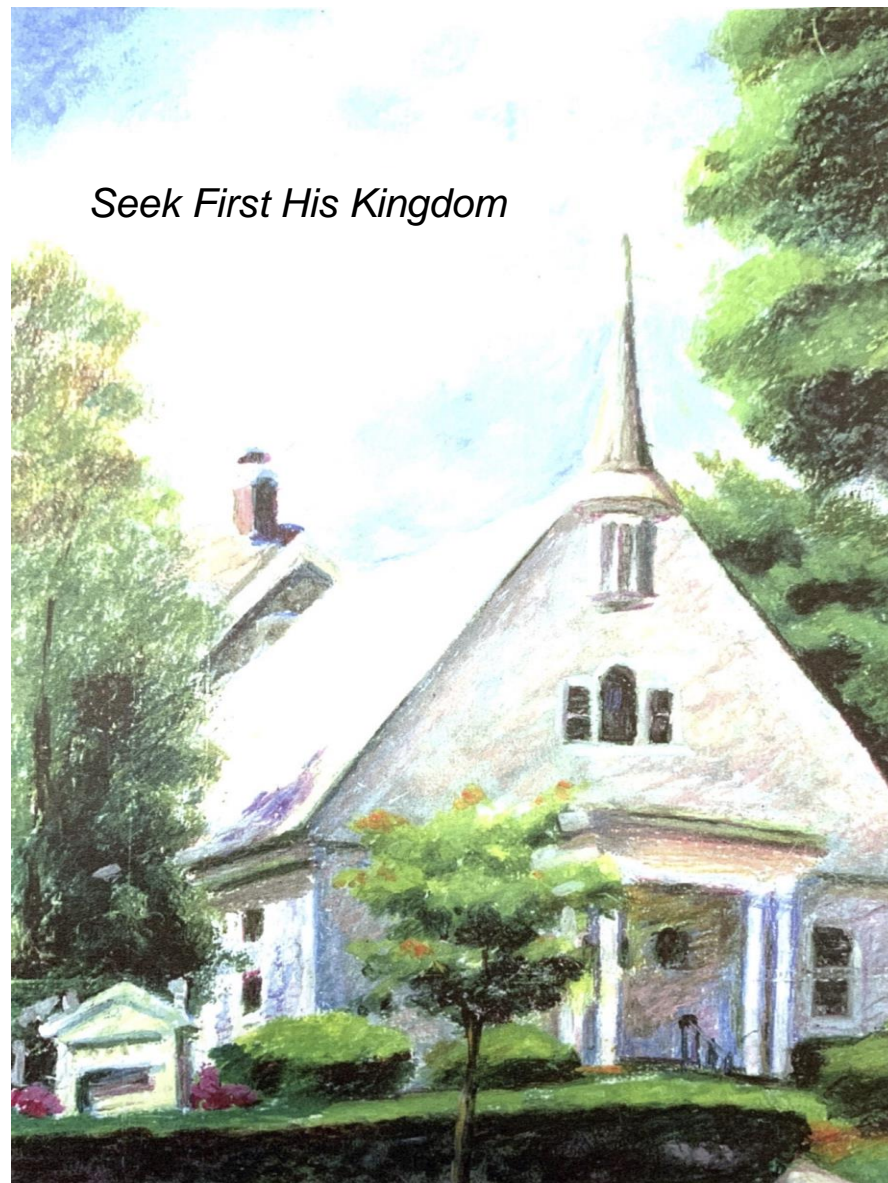
