

Prayer Items

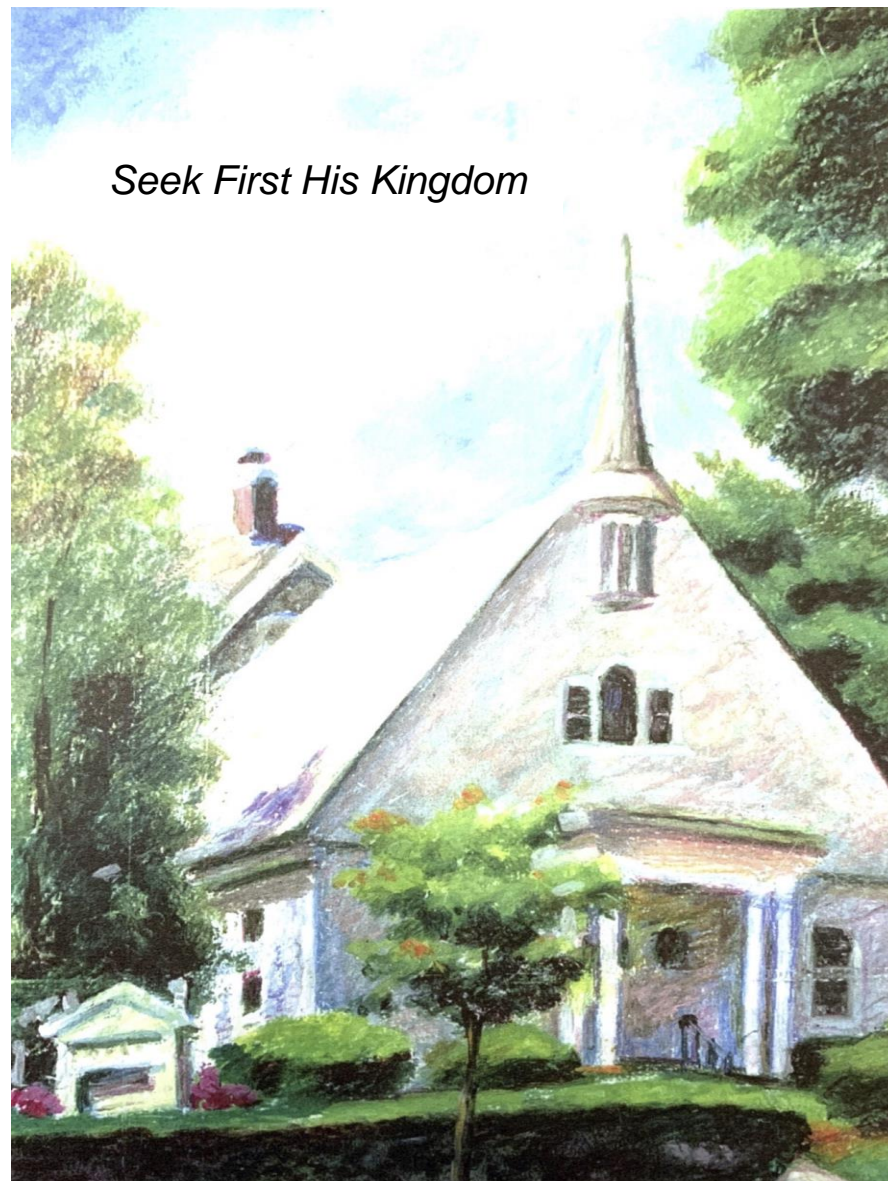
