

Prayer Items

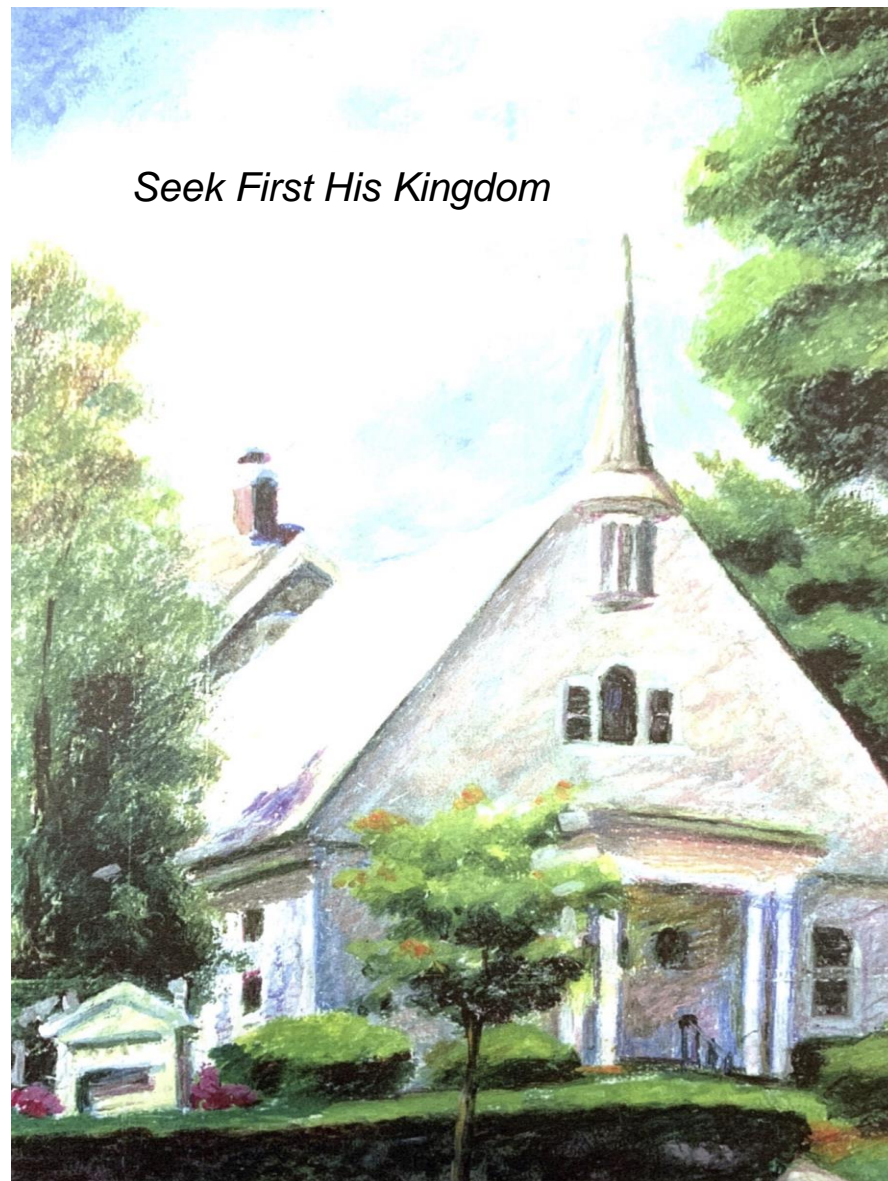
1. Pray for our church's reopening... both for the continued planning by leadership for health-conscious gatherings, and also for readiness in our hearts to gather together to worship the Lord!
