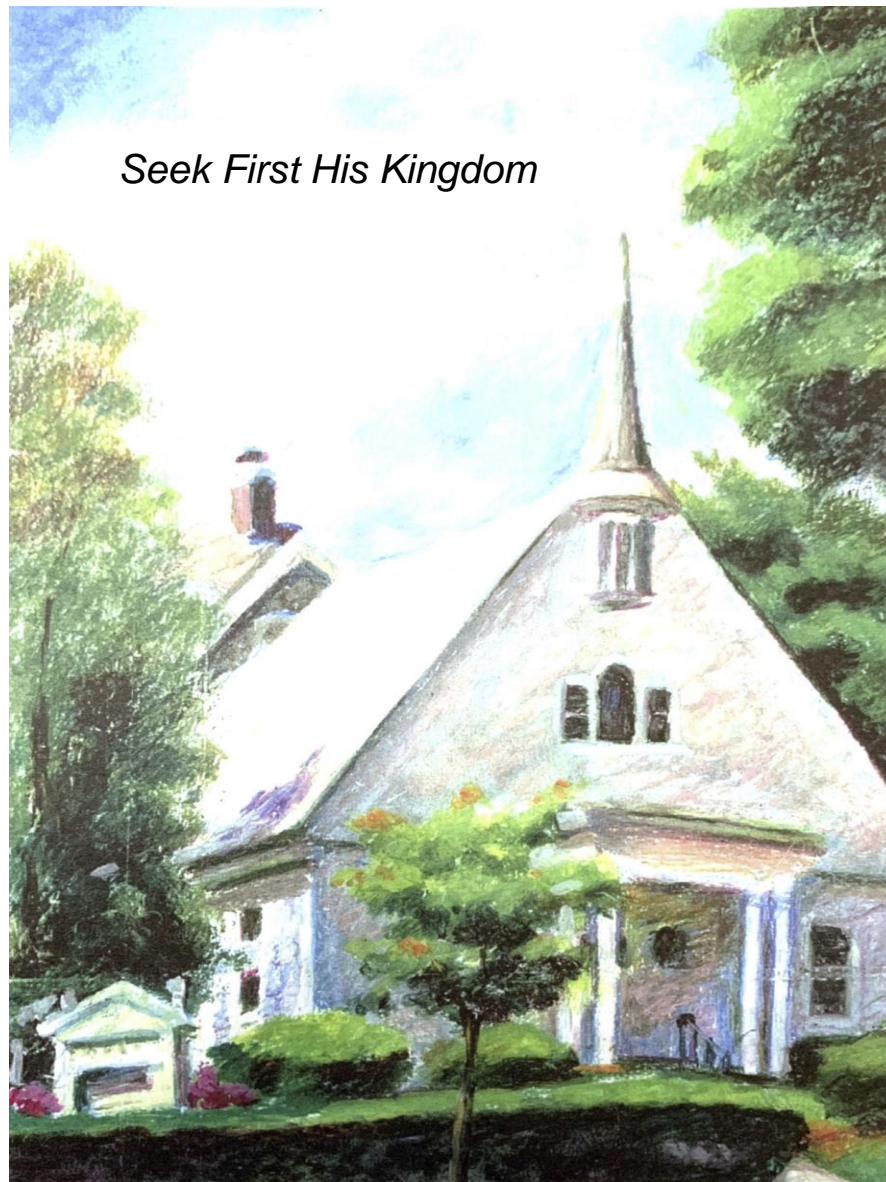

We look forward to this special time together.
4. Because of current health concerns, we will not hold our traditional Thanksgiving Thursday gathering this year. Instead, over the next few weeks we encourage members of our various Bible Studies and fellowships ("Life Groups") to take time in their meetings to share testimonies of God's goodness. Even in a challenging season, there is so much to be thankful for!
