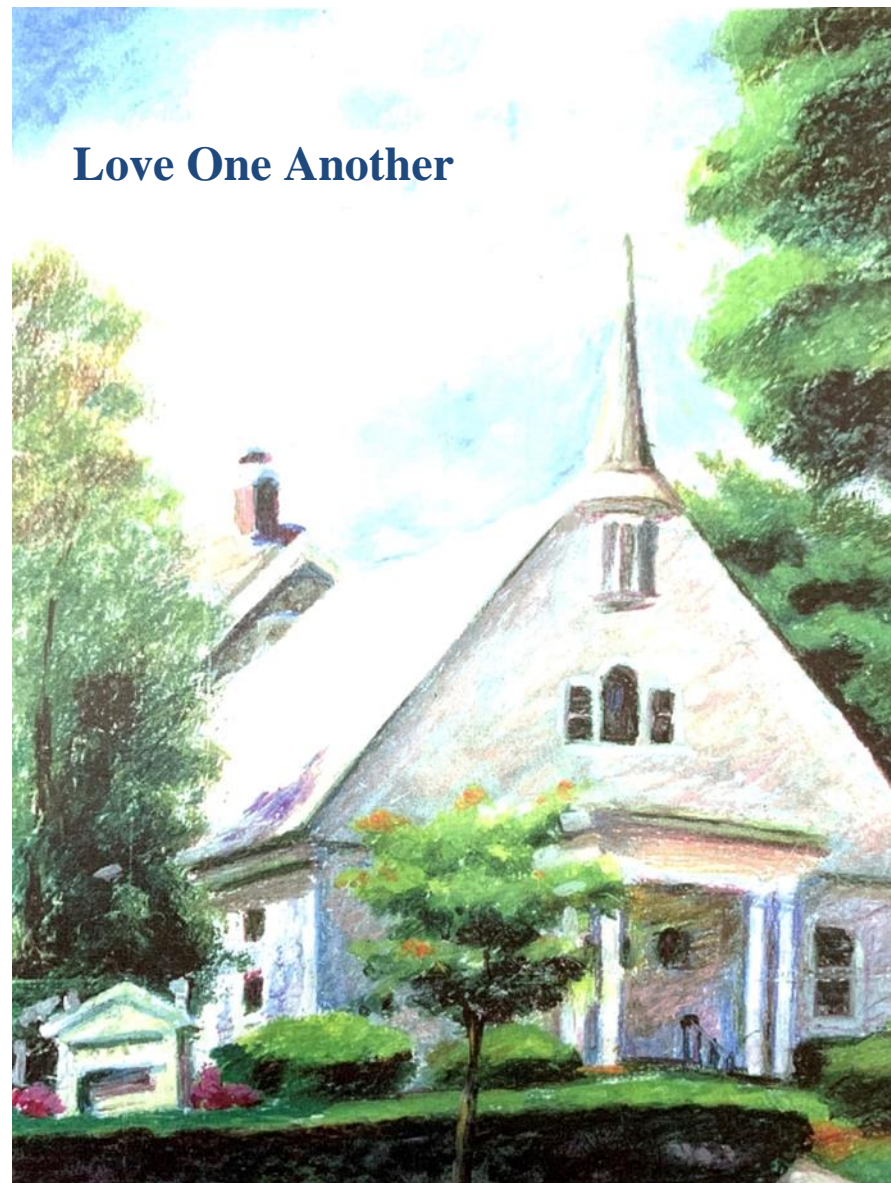


Prayer Items

3. Please pray for Shimu Joyce as she prepares to go on her scouting missions trip to the Middle East. Pray especially that God will resolve her dental condition, which has been painful and distracting, before she leaves for the trip.
4. Pastor Pablo will be leaving CACW at the end of July. Please pray for God's direction and blessing on Pastor Pablo and his family as they seek what God has in store for them.
