

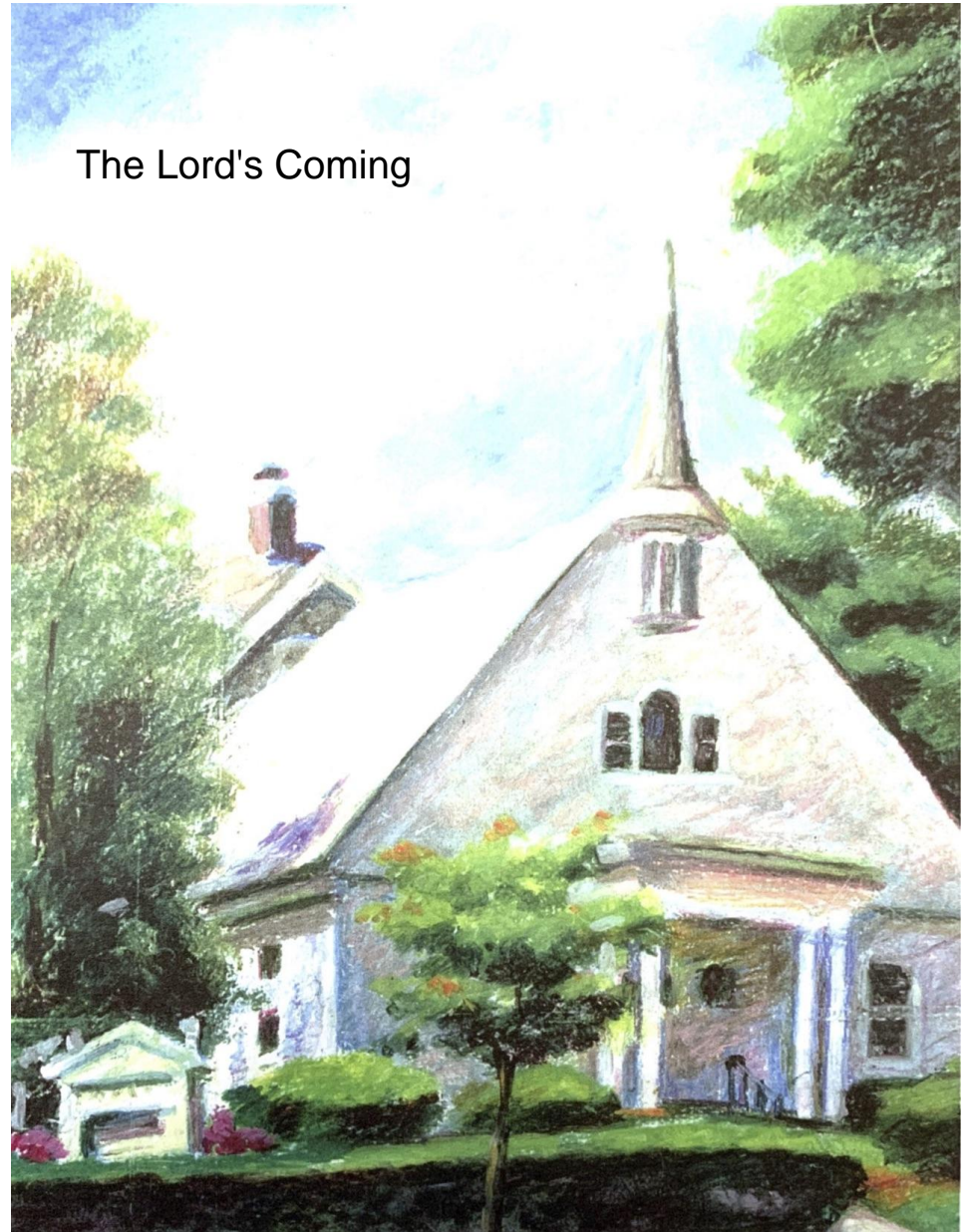
Prayer Items

1. Please continue to pray for people in our country and throughout the world who are anxious and suffering because of political and financial instability.
2. Praise God that Pastor Lee and Joyce Shimu, together with the rest of the Middle East Short Term Missions team, are safely in Lebanon. Their ministry is going well. Pray for safety and energy and strength, as well as for God's blessing on all the arrangements and supplies involved in their work. Pray especially for the hearts of the people to whom they are ministering--that Christ would become very real to them!
3. We praise God that so many of you participated in the recent PEAK survey. The results are being tabulated, and should soon be presented to the Governing Board. Pray for the nine monthly sessions during which representatives of PEAK will lead our Board through training based on the survey. Pray that God's wisdom will guide the whole process!
4. Our church's 2025 annual theme is "The Lord's Coming" (Titus 2:13). Please pray that God will renew our hope in Christ alone!
5. Please pray for those among us who are struggling with illness and physical challenges -- including those whose allergies this time of year make each day challenging.
6. Pray for our young people studying in college. Pray for good rest and refreshment during their holiday break. And as they prepare to return to school, please pray for God's peace, joy, encouragement, and strength to be upon them. Pray for a joyful transition into school life, and also that God would draw these young people into an even closer walk with Jesus.
7. Please pray that brothers and sisters will invite new friends to church to attend Sunday worship and bring others to hear the gospel so that they might come to know the truth, and experience rebirth and salvation. Please pray for the salvation of new friends!
8. Pray for God's mercy regarding conflict and violence throughout the world--including, of course, the conflict between Israel, Hamas, Hezbollah, and Iran, for families in anguish, for political leaders, and for peace.
9. Please pray for the church's fellowships. Some groups, such as the Sisters' Fellowship and Rock Fellowship, have daily Bible reading. Through reading the Bible together, may brothers and sisters be led to draw closer to God and become more involved in caring ministries. Also, pray for the evangelism efforts of the groups, asking God to bring new friends to each group. During this joyful season, may we invite more people to join in fellowship activities.
10. Please continue to pray for our search for an Associate Pastor (who will focus largely on the Youth ministry). Nick Rodriguez, the individual we had been considering, has opted out of the process. Please pray for Nick, and also for our church as we "reboot" the search process.
11. Praise the Lord that there are many new young people attending our Youth Group. Please pray that our Youth Group members will continue to be drawn into a closer and closer knowledge of God, and a deeper walk with Jesus.
12. Please pray that brothers and sisters will have the desire to study God's words, and that they will not only have regular devotional time, but also intimate time with God. Pray also that the Lord would equip and encourage them, so that they might use their gifts to serve God, to benefit others and to glorify our King!
13. Please pray for each fellowship group so that new people can join. Pray also for the group leaders of the fellowship, asking God to give them wisdom and strength

to lead these groups and make them a source of love, fellowship and spreading the gospel. The fellowship also invites many gospel friends to participate through evangelistic meetings.

14. Please pray for all the various missionaries and missions endeavors we support, including the UConn outreach, Pastor Rebecca Mao and COCM in England/Europe, and Pastor Ed Stuart and his work with SALT (Support and Leadership Training). Please pray especially for Pastor Achara -- not only for her ministry with the Pakping Church and Christian School in Khaolak, Thailand -- but also for her health.
