

Prayer Items

1. Pray for the formation, confirmation and work of this year's Nominating Committee -- the group who will identify candidates for open positions on next year's Governing Board.
2. Northeast Gospel Camp is currently meeting (8/29 - 9/1) at Harvey Cedars, New Jersey. Please pray for all attendees, and especially that gospel friends will encounter the love of Jesus and the truth of the gospel.
3. Please pray for Pastor Feng Li and Mrs. Li. They were officially commissioned by the Christian and Missionary Alliance this May, and their whole family will be serving as international workers in Israel, sharing the Gospel with the Jewish people. Please pray for them as they prepare, fundraise, and plan their move by the end of the year, and the presence of God be with them!
4. Please pray for sons and daughters of families among us who are struggling in various ways. Pray for God's help, strength, and wisdom--both for these precious young people and also for their parents as they discern how best to come alongside their children.
5. Please pray for college students returning to school--that God will give them peace and joy as they transition back onto their campuses, and that they will be encouraged in their relationship with Jesus during the semester.
6. Pray for our Governing Board as they meet with a trainer/coach to process and understand the results of the PEAK Survey. (Although the Board is eager to share the results with the congregation, the PEAK coach has advised holding off for now, until the Board itself better understands the findings. The plan is to present to the congregation at the Fall Members Meeting.)
7. Our church's 2025 annual theme is "The Lord's Coming" (Titus 2:13). Please pray that God will renew our hope in Christ alone!
8. Please pray for those among us who are struggling with illness and physical challenges -- including those whose allergies this time of year make each day challenging.
9. Please continue to pray for our search for an Associate Pastor (who will focus largely on the Youth ministry). Pray especially for the Pastoral Search Committee and its work, as they "reboot" the search process.
10. Please pray that brothers and sisters will invite new friends to church to attend Sunday worship and bring others to hear the gospel so that they might come to know the truth, and experience rebirth and salvation. Please pray for the salvation of new friends!
11. Please pray for the church's fellowships. Some groups, such as the Sisters' Fellowship and Rock Fellowship, have daily Bible reading. Through reading the Bible together, may brothers and sisters be led to draw closer to God and become more involved in caring ministries. Also, pray for the evangelism efforts of the groups, asking God to bring new friends to each group. During this joyful season, may we invite more people to join in fellowship activities.
12. Please pray that brothers and sisters will have the desire to study God's Word, and that they will not only have regular devotional time, but also intimate time with God. Pray also that the Lord would equip and encourage them, so that they might use their gifts to serve God, to benefit others and to glorify our King!
13. Please pray for each fellowship group so that new people can join. Pray also for the group leaders of the fellowship, asking God to give them wisdom and strength to lead these groups and make them a source of love, fellowship and spreading

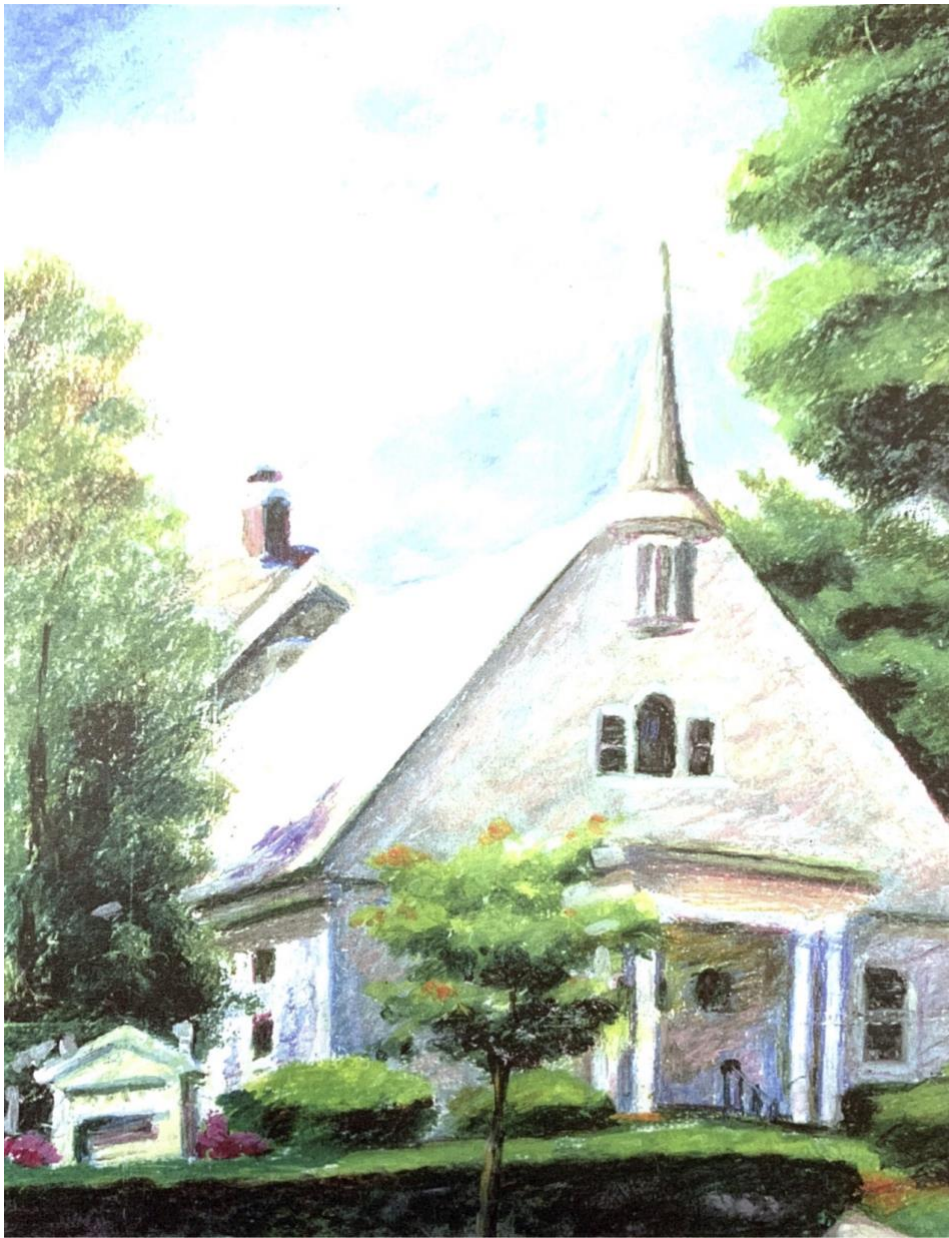
the gospel. The fellowship also invites many gospel friends to participate through evangelistic meetings.
