

Prayer Items

1. Pray for the people in Hong Kong affected by the recent devastating apartment fires. Pray for God's mercy and help for those who have lost loved ones, as well as those who have lost their possessions and homes.
2. Pray for the peace process in the Middle East. Pray for the leaders of Israel and Hamas, as well as for our country, as the hard work of sustaining peace continues.
3. Pray for the two dear sisters and one brother who were baptized on Sunday 11/23. Pray for God to strengthen and encourage them as they continue to walk out their new life in Christ!
4. Please pray for our Pastoral Search Committee as it recommits itself to the search for a candidate for an Associate Pastor who will focus largely on the Youth in our church. Pray especially for the time of fasting and praying they are beginning, and for the Board members and others who will be joining them as they pray in this way.
5. Please pray for our Governing Board as it engages the PEAK coaching process.
6. Please pray for sons and daughters of families among us who are struggling in various ways. Pray for God's help, strength, and wisdom--both for these precious young people and also for their parents as they discern how best to come alongside their children.

8. Our church's 2025 annual theme is "The Lord's Coming" (Titus 2:13). Please pray that God will renew our hope in Christ alone!
9. Please pray for those among us who are struggling with illness and physical challenges -- including those whose allergies this time of year make each day challenging.
10. Please pray that brothers and sisters will invite new friends to church to attend Sunday worship and bring others to hear the gospel so that they might come to know the truth, and experience rebirth and salvation. Please pray for the salvation of new friends!
11. Please pray for the church's fellowships. Some groups, such as the Sisters' Fellowship and Rock Fellowship, have daily Bible reading. Through reading the Bible together, may brothers and sisters be led to draw closer to God and become more involved in caring ministries. Also, pray for the evangelism efforts of the groups, asking God to bring new friends to each group. During this joyful season, may we invite more people to join in fellowship activities.
12. Please pray that brothers and sisters will have the desire to study God's Word, and that they will not only have regular devotional time, but also intimate time with God. 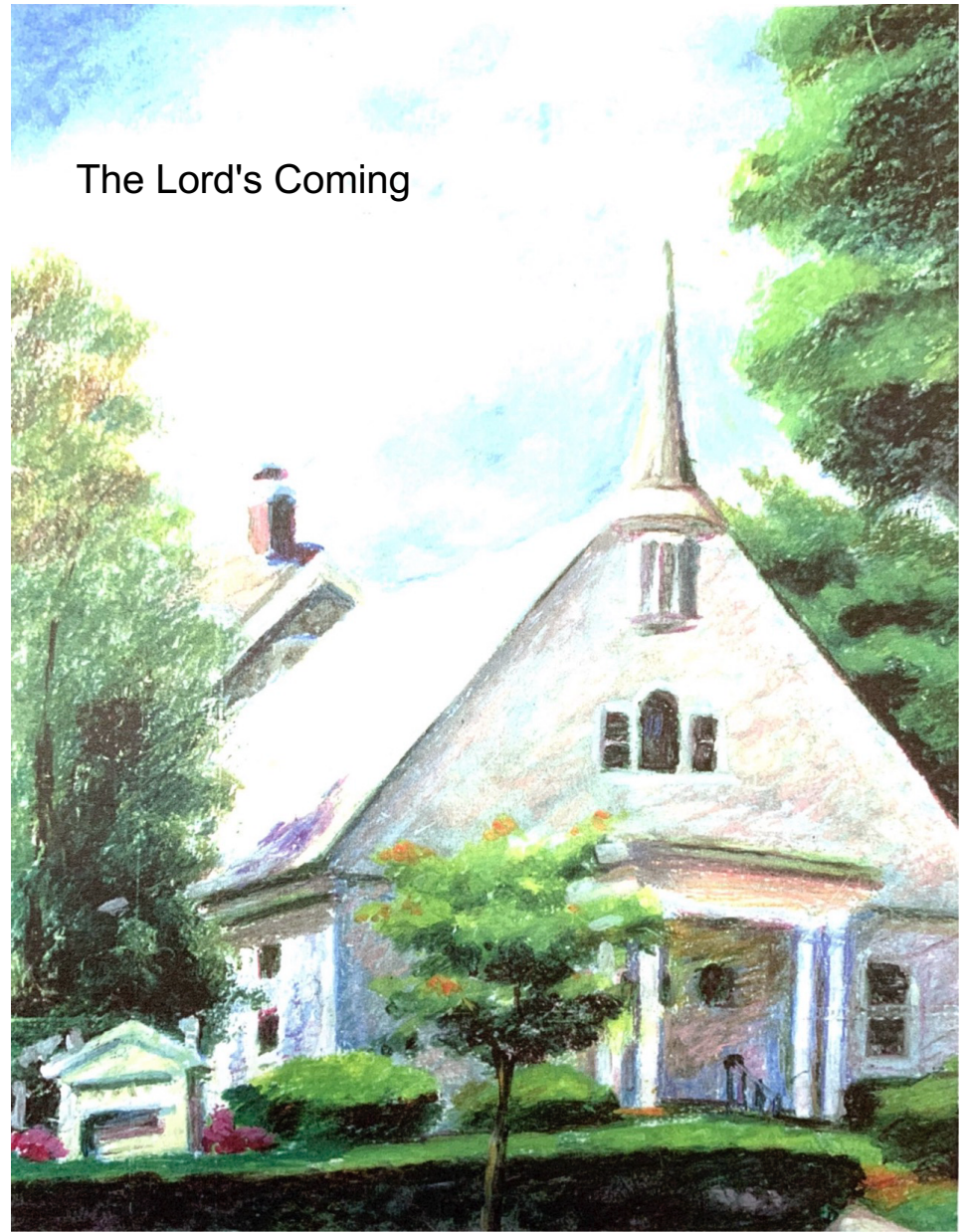
ministry with the Pakping Church and Christian School in Khaolak, Thailand -- but also for her health.
