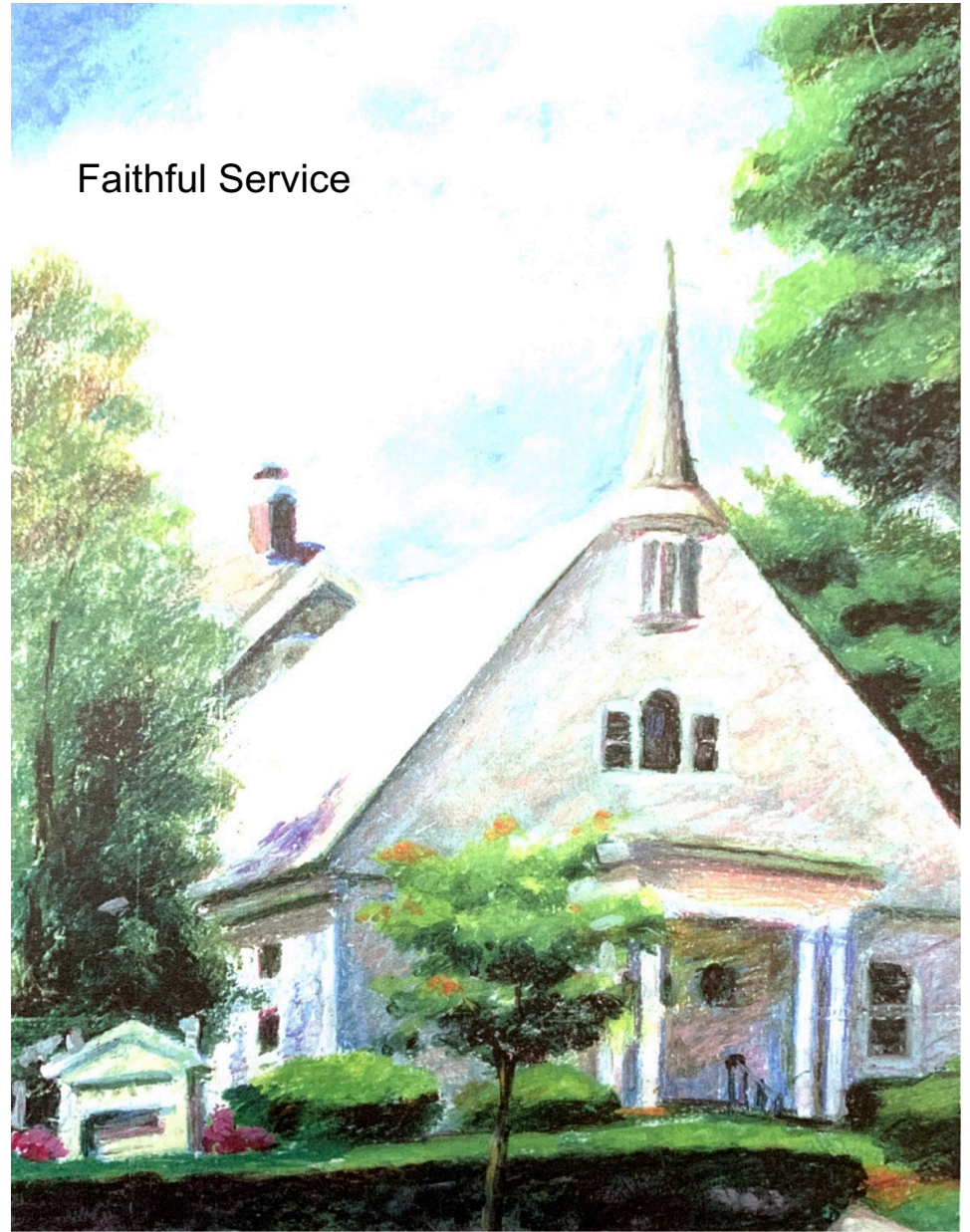


## Prayer Items

3. Please pray for that here in the New Year, God's love to be known to more and more people, and for His blessings to be upon those who love Him. Even though there may be hardships in their lives, God will surely grant us grace to get through the new year! His love and faithfulness will endure forever.
4. Please pray for the confrontation between the protestors and ICE, and especially the clash has led to violence and fatality. Pray that the God of righteousness and prince of peace would reveal His will in the midst of this tension.
5. Pray for the peace process both in the Middle East and between Ukraine and Russia. Pray for God's mercy on those who suffer so intensely from war.
6. Please pray for our Pastoral Search Committee as it continues the search for a candidate for an Associate Pastor who will focus largely on the Youth in our church. God grant them refreshing, encouragement, creativity and help in their task.
7. Please pray for our Governing Board as it engages the PEAK coaching process. Pray also for the Spirit's leading as we follow God's encouragement to better engage our local community.
8. Please pray for sons and daughters of families among us who are struggling in various ways. Pray for God's help, strength, and wisdom--both for these precious young people and also for their parents as they discern how best to come alongside their children.
9. Please pray that brothers and sisters will invite new friends to church to attend Sunday worship and bring others to hear the gospel so that they might come to know the truth, and experience rebirth and salvation. Please pray for the salvation of new friends!

1. We are so glad that you have joined us for today's worship Service. God's blessing on you and your family.
2. Encourage brothers and sisters to participate in a yearly Bible reading plan. Read the Bible daily, pray, recite the scriptures continuously, and keep the word of God in their hearts, so that it will become a daily strength.
3. Everyone is warmly welcome to join our Wednesday evening prayer meetings via Zoom. The prayers of the saints are powerful, pleasing to God, and effective. The Chinese group meets at 8:00PM, and the English starts at 8:30PM (except the first week of each month, when the two groups begin by briefly meeting together at 8pm). Online information on prayer meetings can be obtained from the pastor.
4. We warmly invite brothers and sisters to participate in serving. The sign-up sheet for first-half-of-the-year Sunday volunteer service is posted in the lobby. Please consider signing up to serve the Chinese congregation as a greeter, with altar flowers, or in lunch service (preparing tea and rice, distributing lunch, and cleaning up).
5. With hearts full of gratitude and joy, we'd like to report that our church ended the year 2025 with a surplus of \$107K. In addition, we also received a large amount in the Pastoral Appreciation Fund. We extend our deepest gratitude to each and every one of you who has contributed your time, talents, and resources to support church ministries. We are profoundly grateful for your partnership in ministry. The YE financial statements are posted in the copy room. More details will be shared next week.
6. Church Financials: September income was \$25.4K and expense \$32.4K, resulting in a deficit of \$7K, driven by the recording of the expenses for Youth's Life Conference this month. YTD September income was \$338.5K and expense \$285.9K, resulting in a surplus of \$52.6K. In addition, year-to-date Great Commission Fund collection amounted to \$18.7K. May the Lord bless cheerful givers.
7. The 2026 annual theme is "Faithful Service" (1 Timothy 1:12). May the church, through this theme, serve together in unity and faithfulness as we wait for the Lord's return!
8. CACW's Chinese New Year Gospel Rally will be held at 7:30 pm Saturday, February 28. There will be potluck dinner in the Fellowship Hall at 5:30 pm. This year's theme is "Rethinking Atheism". Dr. John Huang, Moderator of the Elder and Minister Board at RCCC, will be the speaker. Dr. Huang will also preach on Sunday, March 1. Please mark your calendar and invite gospel friends to attend.
9. Chinese Sunday school will begin the book of "Ecclesiastes" on 2/1, starting at 11:40 AM. This book offers readers much food for thought, prompting reflection on the meaning of life. Brothers and sisters are welcome to join us in studying it.
10. Our 2026 Short Term Mission trip to Khaolak, Thailand is planned April 4 - 14, and STM trip to Middle East will be held during April 11 - 22. Please speak to Brother Hong Guo or Joyce Shimu if you are led to join one of these STM trips!
11. Everyone is welcome to join a fellowship group, to live a godly life, study the Bible together and live out the teachings of the Bible!
