

Prayer Items

1. During these severe winter days, please take care to stay warm and be cautious when going out. Also, stay closely connected with fellowship members, supporting and caring for one another.
2. Pray for people throughout the world who are suffering on account of conflicts between nations. Pray for God's mercy and help for those who are suffering.
3. Pray for those who are especially at risk in this cold weather. A number of people without good shelter have already died in New York City on account of the freezing weather. May God show his mercy and his care -- both directly, and through his people!
4. Please pray for that here in the New Year, God's love to be known to more and more people, and for His blessings to be upon those who love Him. Even though there may be hardships in their lives, God will surely grant us grace to get through the new year! His love and faithfulness will endure forever.
5. Pray for the peace process both in the Middle East and between Ukraine and Russia. Pray for God's mercy on those who suffer so intensely from war.
6. Pray for the conflicts between ICE and protestors, which in some instances have turned deadly. Pray for the God of peace and justice to make his ways known in the midst of such a charged situation.
7. Please pray for our Pastoral Search Committee as it continues the search for a candidate for an Associate Pastor who will focus largely on the Youth in our church. God grant them refreshing, encouragement, creativity and help in their task.
8. Please pray for our Governing Board as it engages the PEAK coaching process. Pray also for the Spirit's leading as we follow God's encouragement to better engage our local community.
9. Please pray for sons and daughters of families among us who are struggling in various ways. Pray for God's help, strength, and wisdom--both for these precious young people and also for their parents as they discern how best to come alongside their children.
10. Please pray that brothers and sisters will invite new friends to church to attend Sunday worship and bring others to hear the gospel so that they might come to know the truth, and experience rebirth and salvation. Please pray for the salvation of new friends!
11. Please pray for the church's fellowships. Some groups, such as the Sisters' Fellowship and Rock Fellowship, have daily Bible reading. Through reading the Bible together, may brothers and sisters be led to draw closer to God and become more involved in caring ministries. Also, pray for the evangelism efforts of the groups, asking God to bring new friends to each group. During this joyful season, may we invite more people to join in fellowship activities.
12. Please pray that brothers and sisters will have the desire to study God's Word, and that they will not only have regular devotional time, but also intimate time with God. Pray also that the Lord would equip and encourage them, so that they might use their gifts to serve God, to benefit others and to glorify our King!
13. Please pray for each fellowship group so that new people can join. Pray also for the group leaders of the fellowship, asking God to give them wisdom and strength to lead these groups and make them a source of love, fellowship and spreading the gospel. 

1. We are so glad that you have joined us for today's worship Service. God's blessing on you and your family.

The Chinese group meets at 8:00PM, and the English starts at 8:30PM (except the first week of each month, when the two groups begin by briefly meeting together at 8pm). 5. We warmly invite brothers and sisters to participate in serving. For the English congregation, please speak to Pastor Alan or another leader. For the Chinese congregation, the sign-up sheet for first-half-of-the-year Sunday volunteer service is posted in the lobby. Please consider signing up to serve the Chinese congregation as a greeter, with altar flowers, or in lunch service (preparing tea and rice, distributing lunch, and cleaning up).
6. With hearts full of gratitude and thankfulness, the church's year-to-date income through December was \$487k, with expenses of \$391k, resulting in a surplus of \$96k. In addition, the Great Commission Fund raised a total of \$51K, along with a very generous Pastoral Appreciation Fund. We sincerely thank every brother and sister who has contributed time, talents, and resources to support the ministries of the church. May God richly bless you.
