the gospel. The fellowship also invites many gospel friends to participate through evangelistic meetings.

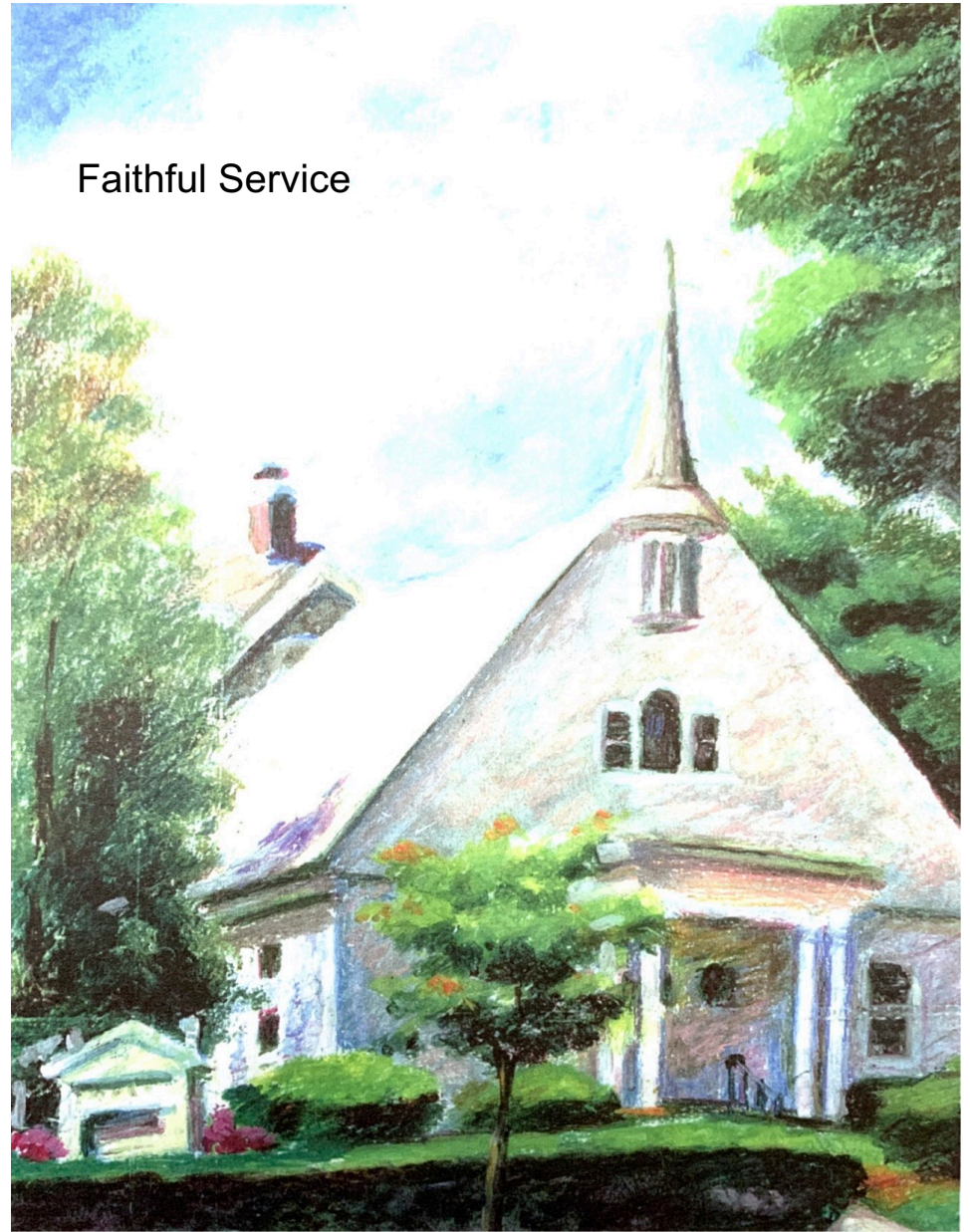
